What do I need to do?

You need to write a reflection about how you've grown as a math student this school year. You will need to look through your folder and pick items to attach to your reflection. Your reflection needs to be at least 2 pages, double space, and font size 12. I came up with a couple of questions to help you get started with your reflection.

1. Thinking back at the beginning of the school year and how you felt about your math abilities, in what ways have you improved? Have you grown as a "math" student?
2. Look through your folder to refresh your memory about what we've worked on this school year. What topic was the hardest for you and why? What topic was the easiest for you and why?
3. For which topic did you work the hardest to understand the material? What was so difficult in that unit and what did you do to make sure you learned it?
4. What do you struggle with the most in math? What do you think you can do to help yourself to do better for next year?
5. Pick one quiz that you are most happy with and explain why you picked that quiz. Pick one quiz that you are not happy with and explain why you received that grade.
6. What are your thoughts about working with "shoulder" partners? Do you like having different partners every 5 weeks?
7. What are your thoughts about working in groups, stations, math poker, scavenger hunt, the foldable booklet/boolets/snowlets, the use of QR codes, plicker cards, lap books, and the many activities we have done in class?
8. What did you think about my website? Was there something you wished I posted on the site? Was it useful? How often did you use it?
9. What are your thoughts on projects? (Slope project, foldable project, and portfolio) Did you have enough time to work on them?
10. What are your thoughts on the foldables and the interactive notebook?
11. What advice would you give to next year's Algebra students about my math class?
12. Did you enjoy board work? Explain.
